Exhibit “B” Rules 2026 Scholarship Rules and Regulations for ‘Teen’

Let it be known that a primary goal of the Miss America Program is to help young women further their education by providing them the in-kind and cash scholarships needed to move forward or continue in school. The primary intent of these educational scholarships is to help provide the financial means to achieve the highest possible level of education.

1. **Scholarships will be awarded to the titleholders and the 1st Runner-Up** (there must be 7 contestants competing in order for us to have a 1st Runner-Up)

Scholarships shall be expended towards college tuition and educational expenses by the Miss Los Angeles County Scholarship Program committee.

2. Requests for scholarships are made directly to the **Treasurer of the Miss Los Angeles County Scholarship Program, Coleen Rockey, at 4190 LaFayette Place, Culver City, California 90232; Telephone: (310) 733-6671.** Request for payment must be accompanied by a cover letter from the titleholder together with the statements and invoices from the educational institution. Payment will be made directly to the educational institution on behalf of the contestant upon approval by the Miss Los Angeles County Scholarship Program Committee.
3. **Teen Titleholder:** If a teen is awarded a title in our competition, she must use the scholarships won in the Miss Los Angeles County Scholarship Program prior to applying for any state scholarships from the Miss California Organization before applying for state scholarships.
4. Scholarships should be used for current or future educational expenses. **Teen Titleholders and 1st Runner** (1st Runner-Up if applicable) should submit invoices for payment directly from the provider of the educational service or may submit a receipted bill and request reimbursement.

All invoices and receipts must be originals and must be current, name, student account, college or university name, as well as current charges must be on the invoice. **Teen Titleholders and 1st Runner (1st Runner-Up if applicable)** may not request payment or reimbursement for payments which are or have been covered through any other financial aid source.

5. Scholarships may not be used for outstanding student loan. A titleholder or 1st Runner Up (1st Runner-Up if applicable) is anticipated to be currently enrolled in a College or University.
6. **Teen Scholarships may be used for future educational expenses. Scholarships will be held on account for the titleholder within the time period specified. Teen Titleholders and 1st Runner (1st Runner-Up if applicable) will have up one (1) year and eleven (11) months after graduating high school to apply for the scholarship with the universal ending date of month and day to be January 31. If Teen Titleholders and 1st Runner (1st Runner-Up if applicable) has not used her scholarship during said calendar years, the funds in her account will be forfeited after the one (1) year and eleven (11) months have passed after graduating high school with the universal end month and day to be January 31.**

An exception to the time limits described above may be made if the **Teen Titleholder** earns title of Miss California's Teen at which time one (1) year is added to the term to collect the scholarship. If the scholarship is not requested within the time limits, scholarship will be forfeited and will remain in the Miss Los Angeles County Scholarship Program Scholarship Account for future awards.
